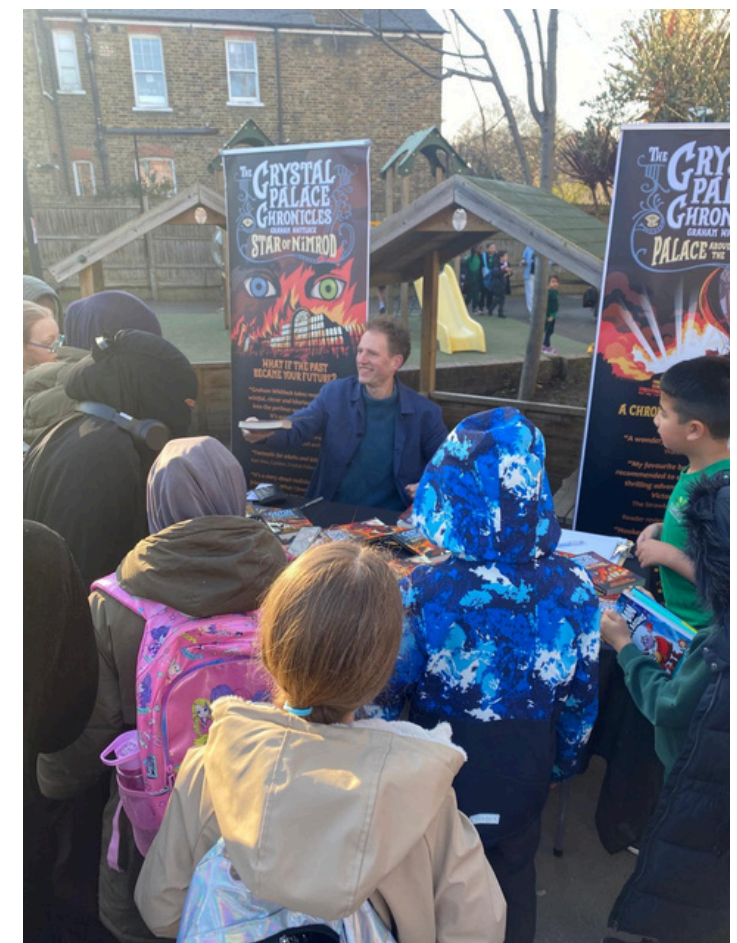
Spring Term is nearly over! Here's a round up of what we've been up to...
